

TITLE OF PAPER

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This document is prepared in accordance with the format requirements of MAIREPAV8 conference proceedings. The MAIREPAV8 Conference Proceedings will be prepared from camera-ready manuscripts received from authors. This manual of instruction is typed in the format that authors should use for the preparation of manuscripts. All authors should carefully follow the instructions given below, and proofread all pages in order to ensure high quality reproduction in the Conference Proceedings. The abstract shall contain not more than 250 words and maximum five (5) keywords. Leave three (3) blank lines between the last line of the title block and the abstract.

Keywords: keyword A, keyword B, keyword C, keyword D, keyword E.

MAIN BODY LAYOUT**Layout of First Page**

The first page contains a title block which should be arranged centrally. The title block contains the title of the paper with all letters in bold uppercase, followed by the names of authors, their affiliations and e-mail addresses. The main text of the paper will begin on the first page after the ABSTRACT.

Manuscript Identification and Page Numbers

All papers submitted have been assigned a paper ID number (Paper ID: xxx) as stated in the abstract acceptance notification sent to you. This reference number should be indicated on the top right hand corner on all pages. Each manuscript should also contain running page numbers on the bottom right corner of each page.

Text

The main text of the paper is to be typed single-spaced on A4 size papers, using Times New Roman of font size 11. All pages must have a minimum margin of 25 mm on all four sides. That is, the left, right, top and

bottom margins must be at least 25 mm. Start from the left margin and type as close to the right margin as possible without going beyond it. Leave one space between paragraphs.

Section Headings and Sub-Headings

Level 1 headings are in bold upper case, level 2 in bold title case, level 3 in underlined normal case, while level 4 is in *Italic*. All headings are Times New Roman of font size 11.

Figures

Figures may appear on the same page as the text. Alternatively, figures may be grouped together at the end of the paper. All figures must be complete with figure number and caption. Figure number and caption should be positioned below the figure, using Times New Roman of font size 11. Drawings and photographs should be in black and white prints. The use of pattern in drawings, instead of colors, to show the differences is preferable. Only clear prints with good contrast should be used.

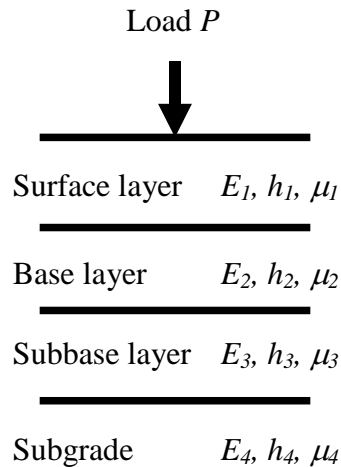


Figure 1: Schematic of four-layer flexible pavement under concentrated load

Photographs

Photographs should be black and white glossy prints. Only clear prints with good contrast should be used. Caption must be provided beneath every photograph using Times New Roman of font size 11.

Tables

Tables should be neatly typed and placed directly on the page. Alternatively, tables may be grouped together at the end of the paper. All tables must be complete with table number and caption. Table captions are to be typed above the tables. Explanatory notes may be provided as footnotes to tables.

Equations

Equations should be made by Equation Editor, placed in the appropriate location, and positioned close to the citation in the document. There should be one blank line before and after the equations. Equations should be numbered consecutively and parenthesized. Equation should be placed center and parenthesized equation number should be placed right using space(s) as needed.

REFERENCES

References should be cited in text by enclosing names of authors and year of publication in parentheses. References should be listed together at the end of the paper. They are arranged alphabetically by the family name of the first author. When two or more references by the same author are listed, the earliest work is listed first. All references listed must be cited in the text. References must contain names of all co-authors, year of publication, title, journal or conference name and issue number (or publisher and city of publication for books). The entire list of references should be single-spaced.

LENGTH OF PAPER

The maximum length of a paper is restricted to ten (10) A4 pages, inclusive of text, tables, figures and list of references. Over-length papers will not be considered for publication in the conference proceedings.

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
